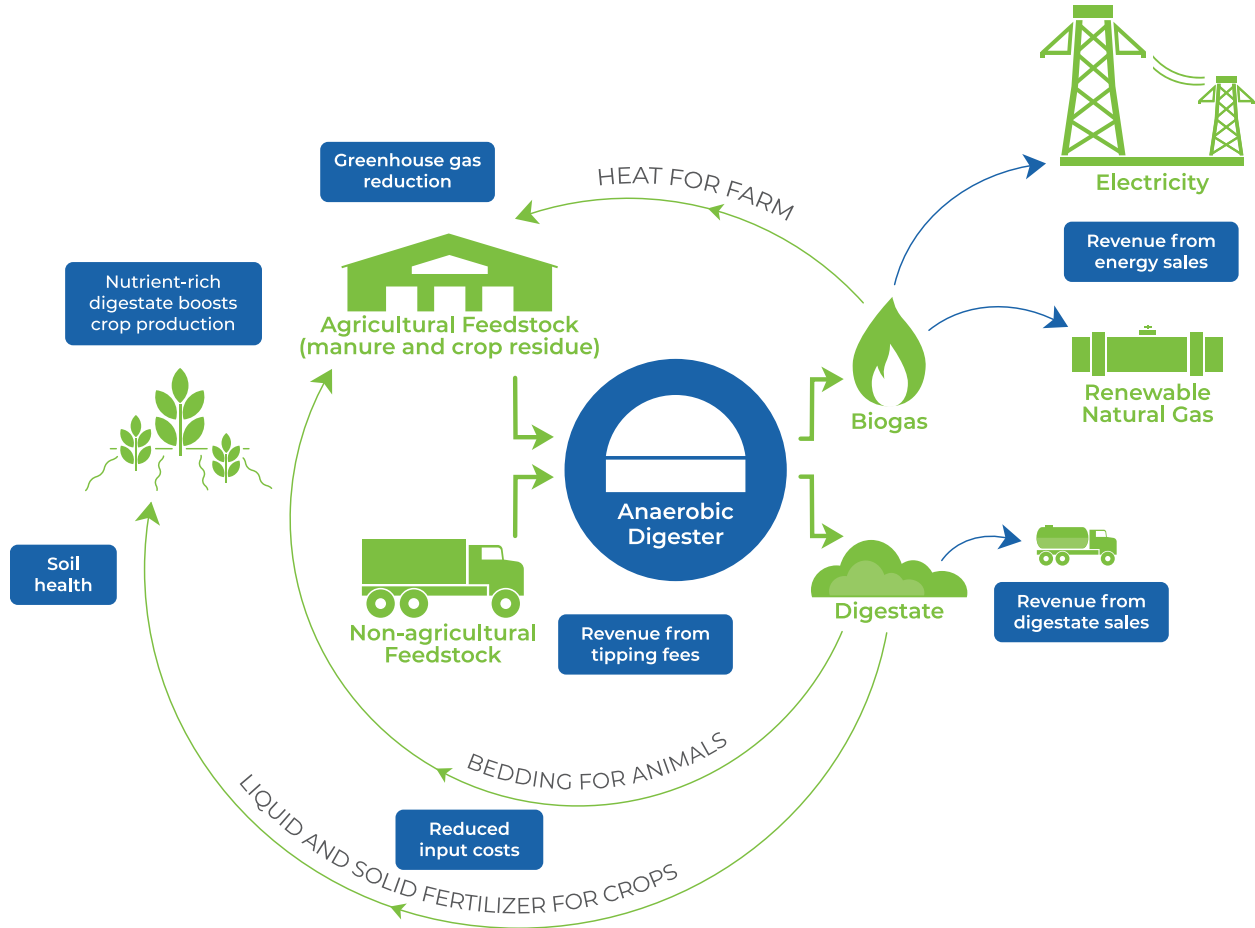


Biogas system flow and benefits to your farm



Definitions

Anaerobic Digestion: A biological process that breaks down organic material in an oxygen-free environment to create biogas.

Renewable Natural Gas (RNG): Biogas can be upgraded to RNG. RNG is carbon neutral and interchangeable with conventional natural gas.

Digestate: A nutrient-rich slurry that comes from the anaerobic digestion of organic material. It can be used as a soil amendment, compost and fertilizer to recycle nutrients.
